"Interpreting everyday vision, portraits, eye expressions, the light falling on flowers and plants, everything with a very watchful eye and taking advantage of the styles of Pop Art and Abstract Figurative. La Porta's work can be described simply as an amalgamation of art and design, natural environments. With meticulous attention to detail, he is inspired by the harmonies of the life: architecture, nature, human been and wildlife; emphasizing connection through dynamic yet meditative patterns. Committed to pushing creative boundaries, Gerardo experiments with new materials and style. His work aims to evoke moments of calm and solace, fostering a deeper appreciation of pattern and connection in human and natural realms. Portraits are more important, the artist dwells on the looks, on the light, on the moment of pause that the face takes as in a photo, to emphasize the state of mind of the person, which reflects of the viewer. Every paint are my words of positivity and the African-tribal lines are my symbols. It is an autobiographical documentary of a life that has touched many facets common to the human nature, natural landscapes and the commonalities and contradictions that ensue."
